PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Kia ora whānau,

You may have seen recent reports that cases of COVID-19 are increasing again across Aotearoa New Zealand. Health advice from the New Zealand Ministry of Health and Health New Zealand Te Whatu Ora indicates that while COVID 19 is now managed as a common respiratory illness, we are currently seeing higher levels in the community.

At school, we will continue to follow good health practices to help keep everyone well.

How families can help

We ask parents and caregivers to please:

*Keep children **home if they are unwell**, especially with cold, flu or COVID-like symptoms.

*Encourage children to cover coughs and sneezes and wash hands regularly.

*Allow children to return to school once they are feeling well enough to participate in learning.

Current health guidance recommends staying home until symptoms improve and you have been fever free for at least 24 hours.

At school we will continue to:

*Encourage regular handwashing and good hygiene

*Ensure classrooms are well ventilated

*Support students and staff to stay home if they are unwell
