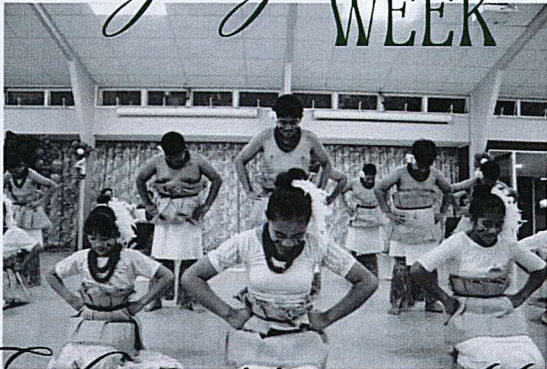
To finish 1st out of 15 primary schools is an outstanding achievement and something our whole school community should be proud of.

Well done boys — you represented our school with pride!



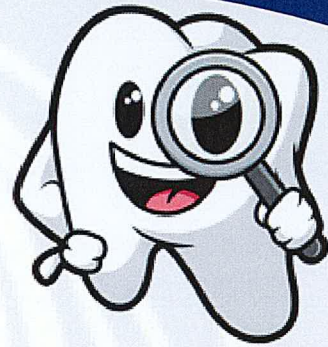
