KEY POINTS ABOUT SCABIES



What is Scabies?

Scabies is caused by a reaction to a tiny mite that digs under the skin and lays eggs.

Symptoms

Small blisters form on the skin and can get very itchy. The redness and small blisters can look like a rash on the skin.

What can I do?

Avoid direct skin-to-skin contact with anyone known to have scabies and don't share personal items like clothes, bedding, and towels. Treat everyone in the household, even if they don't have symptoms.

Who can get it?

It can start anywhere, it can happen to anyone and it won't go away without treatment.

Who can I contact?

Reach out to your **Mana Kidz Nurse** at school for a free assessment and treatment or you can call us on 0800 658 326.

You can also call **Healthline** (0800 611 116).



Mana Kidz is a free nurse-led health clinic on-site at your school

We perform health checks to support your child's needs

The Mana Kidz health team can help with:

- Sore throats
- If your child has a skin sore we can arrange treatment
- Headlice
- Ear health checks and eye checks
- Support with chronic conditions like asthma or diabetes
- Immunisation support
- General checks for students with learning or behavioural problems

After each team's game, medals will be presented for Most Promising Player and Most Improved Player, so please stay around to celebrate the achievements of all our players.

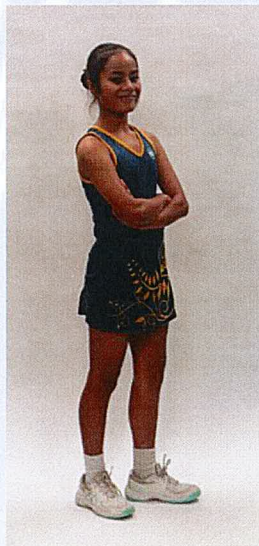
Our Intermediate teams will play their final games on Saturday, 8 August, with finals day deciding the season champions.
